

TAHOE RECREATION - FALLEN LEAF LAKE MARINA SLIP RENTAL AGREEMENT

The Fallen Leaf Marina is scheduled to be open from the Friday before Memorial Day until September 30th (weather permitting)

Hours of operation for launch and fueling are from 7:30AM until 7PM daily.

Maximum size boat is 3100 lbs, 100" beam and 22' length.

All mooring customers are required to register their boat at the Marina office prior to launching.

All vessels must have current state registration stickers and Green Fallen Leaf Wired Tag before launching.

Mooring fees are payable in advance and are non-refundable (make checks payable to Tahoe Recreation or Fallen Leaf Marina.

Mooring customers must maintain protection and indemnity insurance on the vessel moored in the minimum amount of \$300,000 combined single limit for bodily injury and/or property damage liability. Customers must provide insurance certificate within five day of request by Operations Manager.

In emergency situations (at the discretion of the Operations Manager) vessels may be relocated to alternative marina slip location to enhance safety or protect property. The Operations Manager, at additional cost to owner, may remove vessels remaining in the marina after September 30th.

This agreement may be terminated if the conduct of vessel owner or anyone using the vessel is in violation of California State Boating Regulations, local laws, or the Policies and Procedures of the Fallen Leaf Lake Community Services District.

Gangways and slip fingers are not to be used for storage or any activity, including fishing and swimming, which would interfere with safe access to adjacent slip fingers or vessels.

Owners will not be charged a ramp fee for removal of their boat for repair purposes provided Fallen Leaf Lake Marina personnel are notified in writing prior to removal of the boat.

All boaters are encouraged to utilize the marina commercial fueling facility. CSD policy does not allow for the private fueling of vessels within the marina or breakwater area for water quality and fire safety reasons.

Please keep all pets on leash within the Community Area and marina facilities.

Use of mooring facilities is at your own risk. The Fallen Leaf Lake Community Services District and Tahoe Recreation assume no responsibility for vessels moored, recreational or personal equipment and belongings stored in vessels or left on docks, or personal injury incurred while within the entire area.
